

## Personal Injury: Slip and Fall Accidents



Too often, property owners neglect the condition of their property and create dangerous and hazardous conditions for others. Whether a property owner allows ice and snow to accumulate on walkways or a grocery store neglects to clean up a slippery spill in an aisle, these conditions are dangerous.

If you have been injured as a result of a property owner's neglect, you may be able to recover compensation for your injuries. If you have been injured due to a slip and fall accident, you should take the following steps to protect your legal rights:

- Notify the owner or supervisor of the premises of your injury. If possible, fill out an incident report with all the details of both the dangerous condition and your injury. Ask for a copy of the report.
- Seek immediate medical attention for your injuries.
- Consult an experienced personal injury attorney.

Slip and fall accidents are the most common type of premises liability cases, and occur on a daily basis in the United States. In this situation a person trips and falls, or slips and falls resulting in bodily injury. Unsafe conditions on another person's premises, inadequate maintenance and upkeep, construction defects, and/or inadequate security all pose potential threats for painful injuries. Some examples of premises dangers that may cause a slip and fall injury are broken stairs, slippery surfaces, and broken or cracked sidewalks.

A slip and fall accident may take place in many locations, including super markets, the workplace, the library, apartment buildings, shopping centers, casinos, hotels, and schools. Slip and fall accidents may result in a variety of physical injuries, such as:

- Back and neck injuries
- Broken bones
- Concussion
- Head or brain injuries
- Lacerations and bruises
- Paralysis
- Spinal cord injuries



These and other slip and fall accident injuries may require expensive medical treatments, leave you unable to work for an indefinite period of time, and could possibly result in long

term physical disabilities. It is the responsibility of the owner and operator of a property to ensure the safety of all occupants and visitors.
